Welcome to our 2023 Festival – our 55th year

Our 2022 festival was our first live festival since lockdown and we were thrilled to have a wonderful number of performers taking part and feedback from parents, teachers and performers was very positive, with everyone glad to be back to almost normal. It was so lovely to see familiar faces and also to welcome new entrants and their families and friends. It is fair to say that we all needed to get normality back in our lives and a focus for our artistic endeavours.

Following our soloists' weekend seven of our talented music festival performers were invited back to take part in our virtual Milton Keynes Young Musician of the Year showcase and we were delighted to welcome Dr John Byron and Mr Anthony Williams to provide constructive feedback and encouragement to what was an impressive and sophisticated programme. The judges were unanimous in their decisions and highly complimentary about each performers' playing. Each performer was presented with a finalists' trophy, a small amount of prize money and certificate and the impressive piano performance of Alex Wyatt was rewarded with the title of Milton Keynes Young Musician of the Year 2022. Second place went to Ellen Zeng, violinist, who played Mozart – 3rd Violin Concerto in G Major (K216) 1st Movement and Bartók - Romanian Dances Movts 4, 5 and 6 and third place went to Reece Carly Manglicmot with a highly praised performance of the Prokofiev Sonata No 3 in A Minor Op 28. This year the dance festival had over 800 individual dancers registered, but many more performances since dancers performed in solos, duets, trios and groups across 11 different categories of dance throughout the 10 days of the festival. Our adjudicator was Deborah Norris - a renowned Contemporary teacher and choreographer who is currently Programme Manager of Rambert 2 and a faculty member of the Rambert School.

We were fortunate enough to be able to give senior dancers a chance to attend two contemporary workshops given by Debbie during the festival which were very well received

by the dancers attending and parents watching. 2022 was a qualifying year for the AED finals and we were delighted to see many of those who qualified with Milton Keynes moving on through the Regionals to the National Finals in July, with many placing amongst the top dancers in the country. Debbie awarded our bursary for further dance training to Grace Farbon of the Sinead Loughnane Academy. We are looking forward to seeing everyone again in 2023, our 55th anniversary festival.

Please help our festival to grow by telling colleagues and friends about it. Junior performers do not necessarily have to be entered by a school or teacher as parents may send in the entry form on their behalf, and we warmly welcome new entrants of all ages and levels of experience from all over the country, not just Milton Keynes. In addition, we would love to see more schools taking part in orchestral, choirs and ensembles sections.

We hope that you will support the festival in the enthusiastic way you always do. We are completely self-funding and fully reliant on audience support to remain sustainable. We hope you enjoy taking part this year and enjoying all the performances on offer.

Standards for entry for Piano and Instrumental classes are as follows:

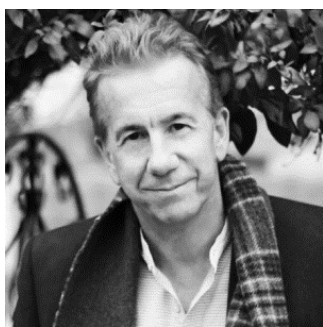
Early Beginners	EB	Not yet playing hands together except for last chord. (class P16)
Beginners	B	Of Prep Test standard or moving toward this grade. (class P13)
Preparatory	P	Grades I and II
Elementary	E	Grades III and IV
Intermediate	I	Grades V and VI
Advanced	A	Grade VII and VIII
Diploma	D	Passed Grade VIII more than one year ago or if you are playing a piece above Grade VIII standard

Marking System

- Every performance will receive a certificate and written feedback and medals are awarded for first, second and third place, with cups or prizes awarded where designated.
- The categories awarded will be in accordance with the standards laid down by the British and International Federation of Festivals as follows:

Fair	A performance limited in its communication
Moderate (up to 80)	A performance showing development of technique and/or communication
Merit (81-83)	A capable performance showing some artistic appreciation / technical ability
Commended (84-86)	A convincing performance technically and artistically
Distinction (87-89)	An excellent performance technically and artistically
Outstanding (90+)	An exceptional performance both technically and artistically

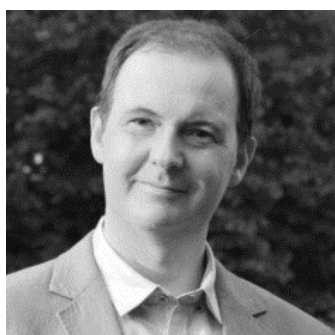


Piano Adjudicator Mark Tanner PhD, MA, Hon BC, FTCL

Mark is a concert pianist, composer, writer and teacher, who has premièred, recorded and broadcast many works by prominent British composers. He has published 65 volumes of compositions and editions for Edition Peters, Faber Music, Spartan Press and Europa Edition. 40 of his pieces have been selected for the exam syllabuses of ABRSM, TCL and LCM. He has various pieces within the popular ABRSM series, Piano Star, and co-authored ABRSM's Teaching

Notes for the previous piano syllabus.

His book, *The Mindful Pianist*, is published by Faber, as is *The Piano in Black and White*, an in-depth guide for the adult learner and returner. His book, *Mindfulness in Music*, is published by Leaping Hare Press in English and Spanish, and *Mindfulness in Sound* was published in 2020. Mark's PhD featured Liszt, a topic on which he has published articles in the UK and USA, and he has written hundreds of reviews for the prominent musical press, including *International Record Review*, *Classical Music*, *Piano Professional*, *Musical Opinion* and *International Piano*. He has written 50 Masterclass articles for *Pianist Magazine*. Mark has given 300 recitals on cruise ships and appeared in the UK's top venues, including five appearances at the Wigmore Hall, Purcell Room and St John's Smith Square. He has performed on BBC Radio 3 and Classic FM. Mark is an ABRSM examiner for grades and diplomas, also a moderator, trainer and international coordinator, having undertaken 45 tours to all continents. Mark was a piano judge for the 2019 BBC Young Musician Competition.



Piano Adjudicator Joseph Tong MA (Cantab) DipRAM LRAM ARAM

Joseph Tong enjoys a busy and varied career as soloist, duo pianist, chamber musician, writer, teacher and adjudicator. Joseph made his Wigmore Hall debut in 1997 as winner of the Maisie Lewis Young Artists Award and gives regular recitals throughout the UK and abroad. He has been a visiting teacher at Wells Cathedral School since 2008 and holds teaching posts at Hampton School and Trinity School, Croydon.

Joseph studied at Wells Cathedral School and Christ's College, Cambridge before completing postgraduate studies at the RAM with Christopher Elton. He has given recitals in Japan, USA, Singapore, Italy, Germany and Spain both as a soloist and in a piano duo with Waka Hasegawa. Over recent years, concerts in Finland have included invitations to perform at Sibelius's home Ainola, the Sibelius Museum in Turku and Helsinki Music Centre. Other solo recitals have included St John's, Smith Square in London, St George's Bristol, St David's Hall, Cardiff and the Presteigne Festival. In 2018, Joseph recorded a CD of Schumann at the Sendesaal in Bremen, for release this summer on the Quartz label.

A keen chamber musician, Joseph is a regular visitor to the Wye Valley Chamber Music Festival, frequently performing with his brother Daniel and in various ensembles. Joseph Tong was elected an Associate of the Royal Academy of Music (ARAM) in 2008. He is Co-ordinator of the Wells International Piano Summer School and joined the teaching faculty of the 2019 Chetham's International Summer School and Festival for Pianists.



Piano Adjudicator Deborah Balding-Brittain ARCM

For as long as Deborah can remember, music has been a very important part of her life. She started playing the piano at the age of five and became a Junior Exhibitioner at the R.C.M. at the age of 11, before becoming a full-time student in 1961, studying piano with David Parkhouse and clarinet with Thea King, having being awarded a Major County Award.

On leaving, she joined the BBC, but on marrying and starting a family, embarked on a very rewarding teaching career. During this time, she also became assistant to the Orchestral Manager of the London Mozart Players, founded by Harry Blech, who was still the driving force behind the orchestra. Leading on from this, she helped in the running of the Serenata of London. She became an Associated Board Examiner in 1982, examining extensively in UK and overseas. In the past few years, she has resumed performing in and around Oxford as well as being asked to adjudicate at Music Festivals, becoming a member of the British and International Federation of Festivals. Recently, she had the privilege of being one of the adjudicators for the Steinway/Malaysia semi-final and final piano competition held in Kuala Lumpur.



Instrumental Adjudicator Gill Johnston AGSM

Gillian studied the bassoon with Archie Camden at the Guildhall School of Music and Drama and, after a period of freelance playing, concentrated on a teaching career, before moving to Harpenden where she established her own Music School, 'Harpenden Musicale'.

As well as running the Music School, Gill arranges Musicale Holidays, Competitions and a Summer Music Festival. She is the founder and Musical Director of the National Children's Wind Orchestra and associated groups.

Gill is an adjudicator for The British and International Federation of Festivals and very much enjoys contact with young musicians, inspiring and enthusing their interest in music.



Vocal Adjudicator Eileen Field ARAM, GRSM, LRAM, ARCM, PGCA

Soprano soloist, accompanist and choral director, Eileen studied at the Royal Academy of Music and is a teacher of singing and piano from beginners to post-graduate level, and gives masterclasses for choirs and solo singers. She is an ABRSM Consultant Moderator, Trainer, Grade and Diploma examiner, and Lead Singing Consultant for the ABRSM Singing Syllabus and the new ABRSM Songbooks.

She has also selected and written performance notes for the Boosey & Hawkes Song Collections. She has examined and presented seminars for teachers in the UK, Southern Africa, the Far East, Bermuda and the USA, and throughout Europe, including Scandinavia, the Faroe Islands, Iceland, Turkey and Poland, and her work as a long-established adjudicator for the British and International Federation of Festivals has taken her all over the British Isles and Ireland. She was appointed an Associate of the Royal Academy of Music in 1998.



Vocal Adjudicator Julia Dewhurst FTCL, ARCM, PGCA, CertEd

A lyric-coloratura soprano, Julia has appeared nationally and internationally on the concert and opera stage in an ongoing performing career spanning over 30 years. Her repertoire is wide-ranging, from Early Music to first performances of contemporary works.

Julia has extensive and relevant teaching experience across the entire age-range. She was for many years a visiting singing specialist in a London primary school working at Foundation, Key Stage 1 and Key Stage 2 levels and leading voice care workshops for teachers.

A popular and much sought-after vocal adjudicator for the British and International Federation of Festivals for over 20 years, she enjoys working with singers towards developing their own personality and individuality in performance.

Julia is a member of the Incorporated Society of Musicians, the Association of Teachers of Singing, the British Voice Association, the Association of English Singers and Speakers for whom she has judged both the Patricia Routledge Competition and the Courtney Kenny Prize and she is a Friend of the Society of the Teachers of the Alexander Technique.
