WELCOME TO OUR 2024 FESTIVAL – OUR 56TH YEAR

Our 2023 festival was our 55th celebratory event and we were thrilled to have a wonderful number of performers taking part and feedback from parents, teachers and performers was very positive as always.

In our Music section, following our soloists' weekend, seven of our talented music festival performers were invited back to take part in our Milton Keynes Young Musician of the Year showcase and we were delighted to welcome Gill Johnston and Martin Wakely to provide constructive feedback and encouragement to what was an impressive programme. The judges were unanimous in their decisions and highly complimentary about each performer's playing. Each performer was presented with a finalists' trophy, a small amount of prize money and a certificate and the impressive piano and cello performance of Matias Yung was rewarded with the title of Milton Keynes Young Musician of the Year 2023. Second place went to Tham Luanghvisut, saxophonist, and third place went to talented pianist Rebecca Bazlov.

We are so privileged to have the continued sponsorship by Kawai Pianos who donate several of their beautiful concert grand and upright pianos to our music festival for our performers' use and we are grateful to Neil and Tom for their generous support and for also agreeing to extend their patronage to the Milton Keynes Young Musician of the Year competition. Without their ongoing support the festival would not be able to accept as many piano entrants as we do (almost 500 performances in 2024) so we are ever grateful for their kindness and generosity and to their Milton Keynes retail partner, Bonners Music.

In our Dance section we had nearly 2000 performances over 9 days. Our adjudicator Kelly Hopkins was very complimentary about the standard of performances and awarded our dance bursary for further dance training to Hannah Digby from Kilburn School of Dance. Our star dancer in the gala section was Ronalee Galheena from Kilburn School of Dance.

2024 is an All-England qualifying year and we have a huge entry in all sections. Our adjudicator this year will be Ms Gayle Johnson. As well as our Dance Bursary we are also going to sponsor 4 dancers through the All-England UK Young Dancer of the Year competition. The competition includes training sessions under industry professionals such as Dame Arlene Phillips and Leanne Benjamin for the Royal Ballet. Several dancers who enter our festival reached the final of the competition which premiered in 2023 and the musical theatre section was won by one of our regular performers, Beatrice Kingsmill Smith from Mayhew School.

Thanks must go to the army of friendly and hard-working volunteer stewards, without whom the festival would not happen, and it was fantastic to all meet up at the 2023 festival and we look forward to getting back together in 2024.

A member of the LAMDA examinations board, she is also a published author of three books of poetry for children. and three books of short dramatic scenes.

Priscilla was a member of the National Youth Theatre before training at the Guildhall School of Music & Drama in London. In 1972 she founded her own drama school in the Midlands, which she handed over to her daughter in 2013, although she continues to teach youngsters and adults at her home studio. Priscilla was a LAMDA examiner for 34 years and examined worldwide. She has been an adjudicator in

Speech & Drama for the British and International Federation of Festivals since 1991 and has adjudicated in Bermuda, Sri Lanka and Hong Kong. Priscilla is a published author on Shakespeare and has directed and acted in over 40 plays, musicals and pantomimes during her performing life. Now, she spends most of her time in the business sector with her company, Loud & Clear voice coaching. As a professional speaker she appears at conferences and enjoys entertaining audiences on P&O cruise ships.

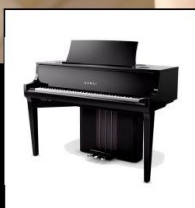

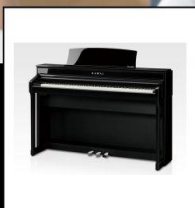
